Extent to which the delegation representing the country at the COP meeting is gender balanced

Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women

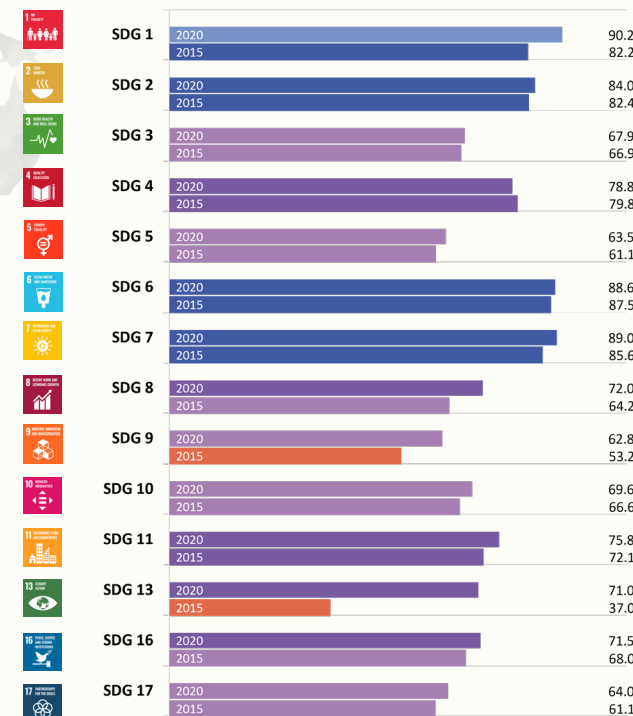
Military expenditure as a percentage of GDP

Palma inequality ratio (the share of income of the richest 10% of the population divided by the share of income of the poorest 40%)

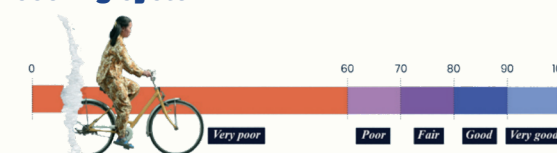


EQUAL MEASURES 2030
