

Extent to which laws criminalise, protect or recognise sexual orientation and same-sex conducts

Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women

Proportion of women (15+ years) who report they are satisfied with public transport in their area


Extent to which women can openly discuss political issues in private and in public spaces

Proportion of women (15+ years) who report having had enough money to buy food that they or their family needed in the past 12 months
