Improved

Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women

Proportion of women who have made or received digital payments in the past year

Proportion of women with access to internet services

Extent to which a national budget is broken down by factors such as gender, age, income, or region

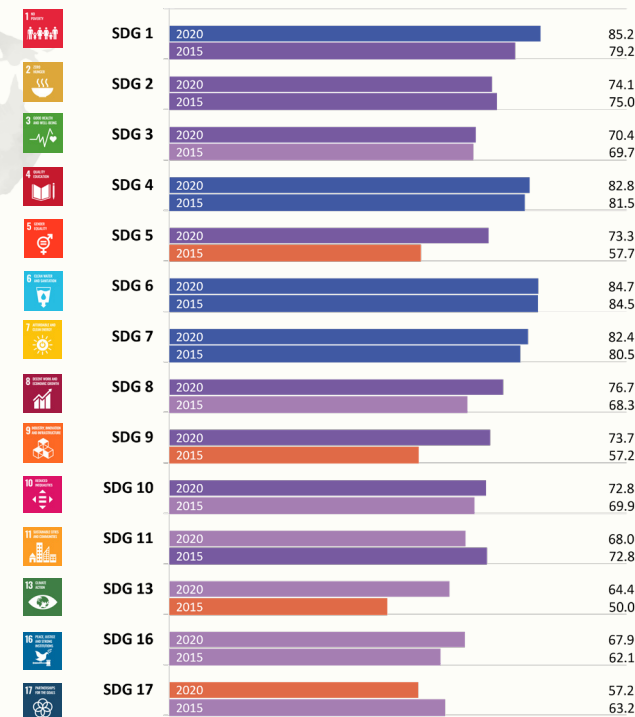
Proportion of women (15+ years) who report they did not have enough money to provide adequate shelter or housing in the past 12 months

Tax revenue as a percentage of GDP

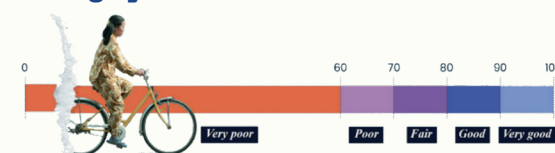


EQUAL MEASURES 2030
