Improved

Extent to which laws criminalise, protect or recognise sexual orientation and same-sex conducts

Extent to which the delegation representing the country at the COP meeting is gender balanced

Proportion of women who hold a bank account at a financial institution

Declined

Proportion of women (15+ years) who report having had enough money to buy food that they or their family needed in the past 12 months

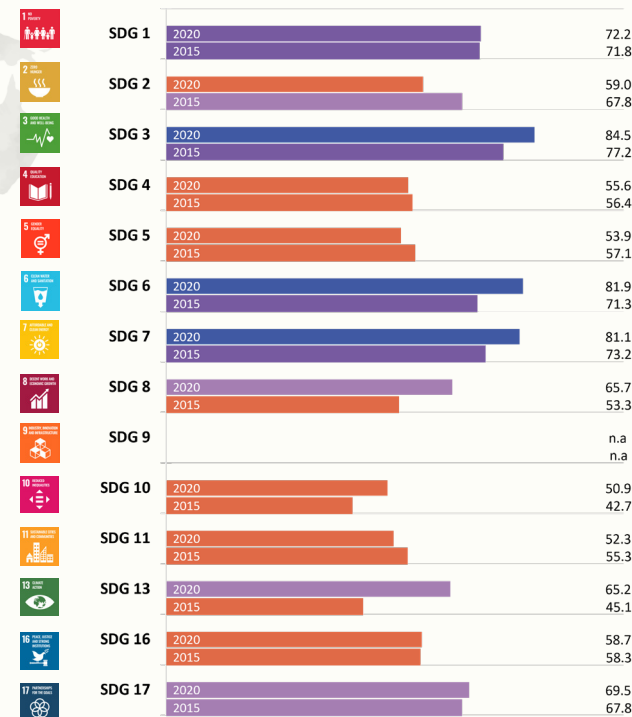
Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women

Proportion of women (15+ years) who report they did not have enough money to provide adequate shelter or housing in the past 12 months

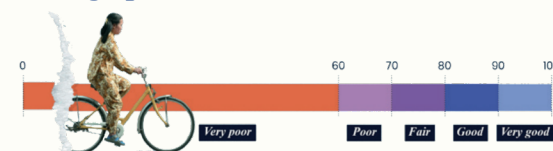


EQUAL MEASURES 2030
